



↳ Background

The Wisconsin National Guard Challenge Academy is a residential program committed to improving the quality of life for Wisconsin's teens. Sixteen and nine months through eighteen year old at-risk teens. We offer habitual high school truants an opportunity to obtain an HSED (High School Equivalency Diploma) and to change their lives in a positive manner.

↳ The Challenge

The challenge was two-fold; to be able to manage and oversee the use of 50 student computers located in 4 different buildings for an "At-Risk Youth" program and encourage teacher - student interactivity spread amongst these computers.

↳ NetSupport Solution

Our layout consists of a 30 PC lab and 20 other student PCs located in 3 different buildings that students perform study hall in. All student PCs have NetSupport School installed allowing for centralized monitoring which greatly reduced the amount of staff required. Teachers can interact or monitor assignments from one spot thus increasing class size.

↳ Testimony

The greatest value that we receive is the ability to manage/monitor all student computers from a centralized location. This allows for us to have more students on the computers at a time than previously. Because we are a school for "At-Risk Youth," our policy is that students will be monitored at all times while on the computer. We were limited to 30 students in the lab at a time. Now we can use all 50 PCs and monitor from one location.
